Hello Fred,

I have been advised -The shipments were erroneously stopped by FedEx's automated fraud models. Our models analyze multiple data points to assess a shipment's risk to FedEx. Shipments are intercepted when the models determine there is a high risk that FedEx will not be compensated for the shipping charges. The algorithms tied to the risk assessment are proprietary and cannot be shared. The automation has less than 1% false positive rate (e.g. legitimate shipments that should not have been stopped). This means customers with legitimate shipments intercepted should not change their shipping behavior due to incorrect fraud stops, unless otherwise noted. Our team continuously analyzes false positive events to improve models and prevent new false positive occurrences. In addition, we can add specific accounts to a positive list that excludes them from future risk assessment.
